What is the John and Priscilla Legacy Society?

Answer: The Society is a way to ensure that you are remembered for supporting preservation of John and Priscilla's legacy and their impact on our country.



How does one become a member of the John and Priscilla Legacy Society?

Answer: There are several ways to become a member.

1) The easiest way is to make a bequest to the Alden Kindred of America (AKA) via your will. This is easily done by contacting your attorney or financial adviser.

2) You can also create a testamentary charitable remainder trust which provides income for your designated beneficiaries during their lifetime, or for a designated number of years. Your beneficiaries will be taxed on the income they receive during the life of the trust, but when the trust matures, the Alden Kindred will receive any remaining funds.

3) By naming the Alden Kindred as a beneficiary of your retirement plan – either as an outright bequest or as the named beneficiary at the termination of a testamentary charitable trust.

4) Your financial gift to The Alden Kindred of America, either by an outright bequest or by naming the AKA as the beneficiary at the termination of a testamentary charitable trust, entitles you to have your name inscribed on a plaque as a member of the John and Priscilla Legacy Society, which will be prominently displayed.
