



DONNELL B. YOUNG SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Be a Lineage member of the Alden Kindred of America, Inc.

Be a graduating high school senior planning to attend college after graduation.

Properly complete and submit the scholarship application, high school transcript (mailed from your school), and required essay (approximately 250 words): *“What It Means To Be An Alden.”*
Deadline is March 1, 2026. Application should be mailed to Alden Kindred of America, Alden House Historic Site, PO Box 2754, Duxbury, MA 02331.

The winner will be announced by May 31. The decision of the Committee will be final.

The scholarship will be presented at the annual Alden Kindred meeting held on the first Saturday in August on the grounds of the Alden House Historic Site.

If you cannot attend the Annual Meeting in person, the scholarship check will be mailed to you upon receipt of a letter confirming proof of college acceptance.

Note: This award was raised to \$2500 in 2024 but the exact amount of the scholarship awarded will depend on funds available.
